Spring

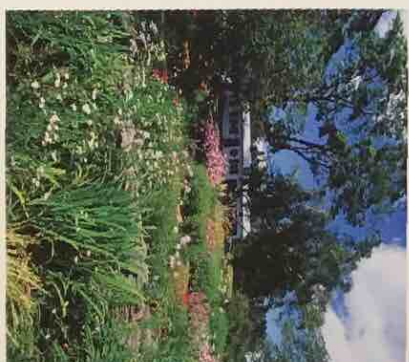
Redbuds, lilacs, azaleas, rhododendrons, and crabapples stir the senses.

The Farm House sits behind the terraced perennials of the Gardens.

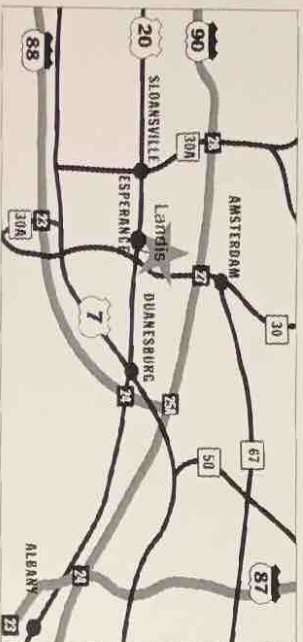

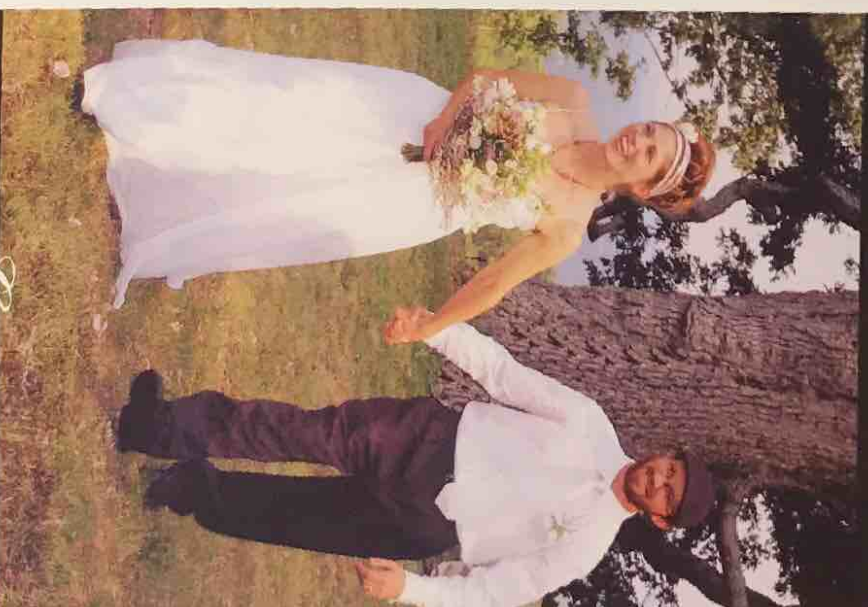


Landis Arboretum is located at 174 Lape Road, Esperance, New York, only 30 minutes from Albany. It is one and a half miles north of Route 20 in the village of Esperance. Follow the signs from the Town Hall to Lape Road. The Arboretum is one-quarter mile straight ahead.

- Arboretum grounds are open daily from dawn to dusk. Please sign in at the kiosk located in the parking lot across from the main gates when you visit.
- Landis is free to the public. A donation of \$5 is suggested for non-members to help us continue to provide programs and activities, and to maintain the grounds for everyone's enjoyment.
- Well behaved and leashed dogs are welcome. Please pick up after them and do not allow them to enter the perennial gardens.
- We ask that you "pack in and pack out" your trash, as no facilities are available for disposal.
- No guns, horses, or motorized vehicles are allowed at Landis.
- Removal or collection of flowers, cuttings, seeds, or other plant material is prohibited without prior permission from the Arboretum staff.
